

Instructions for the Long Term Radon in Air Test

1. WHAT THIS PACKAGE CONTAINS

This package is used to test radon in air for three months to one year. It contains:

- These instructions with Data Sheet attached
- Black alpha track type detector(s) sealed in clear bag(s)

DO NOT OPEN THE BAG UNTIL YOU ARE READY TO TEST.

- Return mailing envelope

2. CHOOSE THE ROOM TO TEST

The US EPA recommends you test the lowest level of the house that is regularly used for 8-10 hours per week. If you are making a follow-up measurement, the US EPA recommends placing a detector on each floor of your home that is used for living space. Do not test in the kitchen, laundry area, bathroom, crawl space, furnace room or closet.

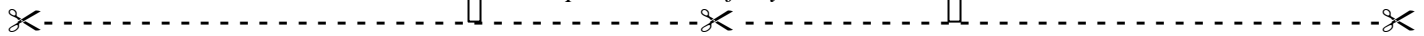
Write where you test on the Data Sheet on the line marked "Room / Location Tested".

6. RETURN THE DETECTOR(S) TO THE LABORATORY

Make sure the Data Sheet is complete. Detach the Data Sheet and slip it and the detector(s) into the mailing envelope. Write the detector number(s) here. Seal the mailing envelope, affix proper postage and drop it in the mail.
